

## Presentation of Coins Format

Hi, I'm \_\_\_\_\_ and I'm an Overcomer. (Pause for the response, "Hi, \_\_\_\_!")

At Overcomers, we believe the most important person in the room is the newcomer. We all know what it took for you to come through that door for the first time. Welcome. We have a special gift we want to give you. This is how we welcome you into our family. Is anyone here for the first time in an Overcomers Meeting? Please stand and tell us your name. (Repeat their name, give hug, give chip to each newcomer.)

The front side of that coin says, "Never Alone Again." Carry it with you to remind you of our commitment to you, as your new family, that you never have to be alone again in your struggles.

Is there anyone coming back to us who would like another welcome chip? Or does anyone want to begin a new journey? (Give hug, give chip.)

We also celebrate monthly increments of recovery. Is anyone celebrating 30 days of recovery? (Give hug, give chip.) ... 2 months? (etc)

Is there anyone celebrating annual increments of recovery this month? How many years? (Make a record for Birthday Night) We look forward to celebrating with you the last Saturday night of this month.

(If there is a coin of the month, read the coin, then pass a bag of them around for each one who doesn't have one yet to take one.)

## Presentation of Welcome Kit

Hi, I'm \_\_\_\_\_ and I'm an Overcomer. (Pause for the response, "Hi, \_\_\_\_!")

(Address the Newcomers by name by reading their names off the envelopes)

We have another gift for you before you leave the meeting. While everyone was sharing, your brothers and sisters in the circle tonight have written their names and phone numbers down. They did so with the expectation that it be *used*. You never *have* to be alone again in your struggles. Pick up the phone. Use the number so you don't *use*. Call one of us 24/7. We know darkest the times inside are when it's dark outside.

(Then give them the envelope and of course, give another hug.)
